

China Tibetan Culture Forum held in Nepal

(Kathmandu Post; People's Review) The China Association for Preservation and Development of Tibetan Culture (CAPDTC) and Nepal Arniko Society (NAS) launched a two-day event, the China Tibetan Culture Forum, at the Yak & Yeti Hotel in Kathmandu.
